# A special mention about the Tiffin Service:

We are proud to share the progress made in this newest enterprise. While it will take us some time to become self sufficient, we have moved from an income of 36 thousand (September-March 22-23), to 3 lakhs plus in 23-24, from April to March, reaching almost 400 orders in the month of March 2024!

#### Health

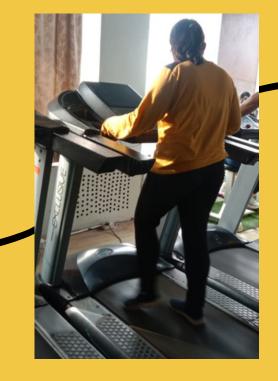

Here are some notable examples of professional development undertaken in the last year





### The Tools Workshop:

A two day training program that Project Arunima initiated and invited other organizations as well to (Latika and Raphael attended). The attendees were trained in using tools for person centered planning.









#### 1. Community Mapping

Our work audit done last year revealed that we needed to go out more and ensure that the friends were able to use resources available in the community. A follow up training by The Keystone Institute of India taught our staff to Map the Community for existing resources to use. This training required them to go out and explore potential places. The staff reported that this was a very useful exercise and they realized there were many community activities and places they were not even aware of till they did this activity.



#### 2. DSP training

There is a great need for trained Direct Support
Professionals who can provide holistic, respectful
and informed support to the people they serve.
Special Educators, who are geared towards schools,
and not really suited for adults, just do not fit the
needs so many families have. The Keystone
Institute in collaboration with heads of
organizations including Project Arunima started
developing a course specific to DSPs in 2020. What
has resulted is a well rounded certification course
that trains Master Trainers to then run the course
for others

The Director, Ms. Aparna Das is a certified Master Trainer for "Foundations of Direct Support" and many of the staff of Arunima are now halfway through the certification course.

The Building Project is well underway, with the outer structure slated to be completed by December 2024, after which the work on interiors will begin.

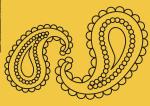
